Q. What is the process of being a volunteer?

Ans. The Interested person may register their interest to work as Volunteer and areas of intended contributions. The Form is available at our website.

Q. How can I be a part of the foundation?

Ans. By becoming Volunteer / Intern / Donor.

Q. What is the minimum amount for donations?

Ans. There is no minimum amount fixed for donation.

Q. Will we get a certificate if we do the volunteer programs?

Ans. We will issue the appreciation letters to Volunteers and certificates to Interns.

Q. Which places this foundation is actively providing their help and supporting through their volunteering activities?

Ans. The Program is open PAN India but in the first phase we are preferring to support students within 200 km radius of Delhi.

Q. What are the ways or activities in which a person can volunteer?

Ans. Raising Donations for Foundation, Identifying the needy students and spreading awareness about the program and in many other ways.

Ans. 90% and balance 10% is organization expenses. No Trustee / volunteers is paid any remuneration/ reimbursed for any expenses.

Q. How are you verifying whether the students genuinely in need?

Ans. We verify various documents submitted by students including Mark sheet, bank statements, Identification and address proofs. For further verification we visit the students' families and school to verify their genuineness.

Q. As a donor how will I be able to know that the money I donate is genuinely going to the students in need?

Ans. The Foundation is subjected to annual Audits. Besides You can always ask for details of beneficiaries (in strict confidence) and verify the various relevant documents of Foundation.

Q. Will the students living only within a 200 KM radius of Delhi be eligible?

Ans. In the first phase we are aiming to help students staying in 200 Kms of Delhi, however if we receive any request for any students beyond this and details / case is verifiable, we will try to help.
